Program

We meet at the entrance to the **Botanical Garden** at the gate at Große Wallstraße at 13:30. The Botanical Garden of Martin Luther University Halle-Wittenberg is one of the oldest botanical gardens in Germany. It was founded in 1698, has a size of 4.5 ha and included greenhouses with a total space of 3000 m². In the end of the 18th century, many greenhouses were constructed. Recently, additional modern greenhouses have been build and old ones renovated. The Botanical Garden Halle keeps many important collections. Among them are special systematic collections of orchids, bromeliads, carnivorous plants, grass species, Cactaceae and Alismataceae. Another focus is the collection of Central Asian plants, especially from Mongolia as well as on plants extinct in the wild and nearly extinct plants with regional emphasis on Saxony-Anhalt. In total, the garden harbors about 12.000 species.
